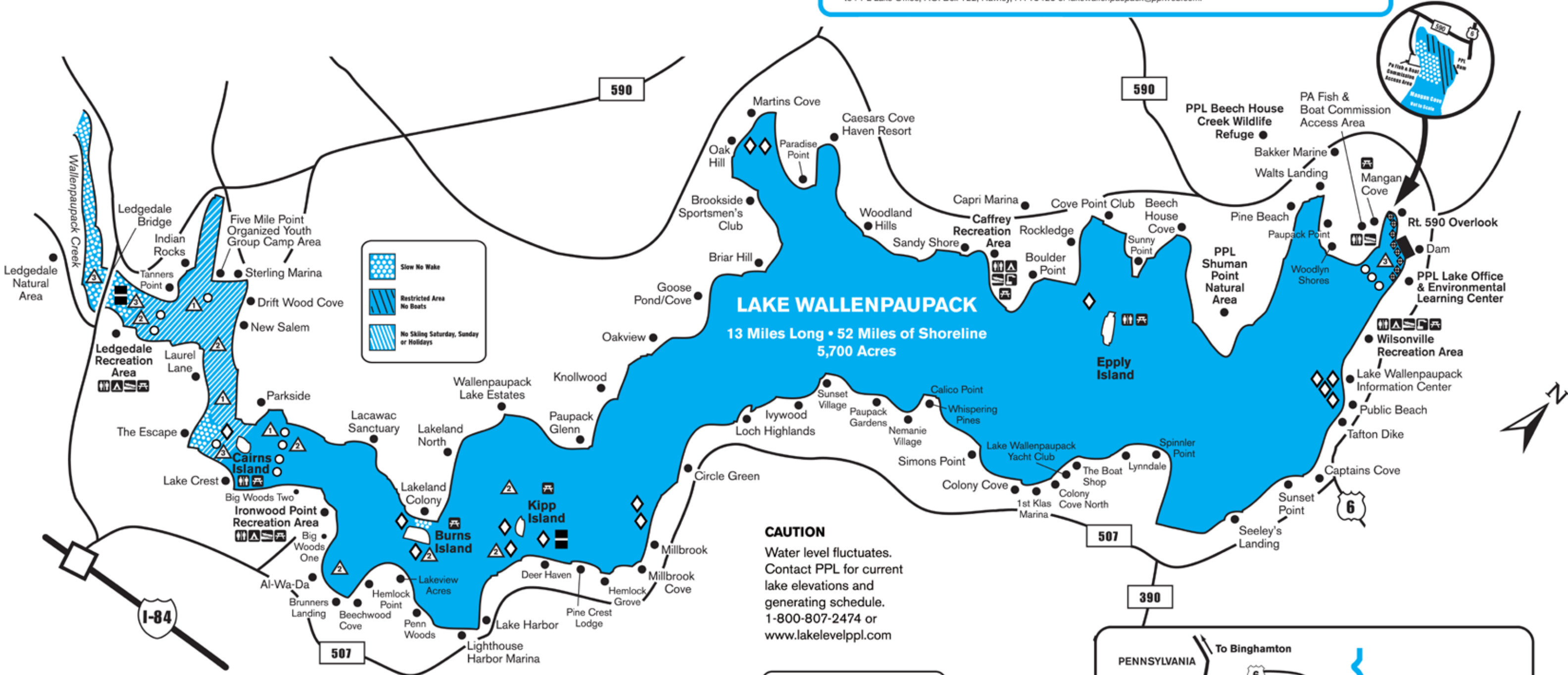

## LEGEND

- Water-skiing or towing of an aquaplane, disc or similar device is prohibited on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays at the western end of the lake from a line marked by buoys about 200 yards east of Cairns Island to the Ledgesdale Recreation Area.
- Kite-skiing and parasailing are prohibited on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays at all locations and at all times from Ledgesdale Recreation Area to Kipp Island/ Wallenpaupack Lake Estates.
- The speed of boats is limited to a slow, minimum-height swell in the following areas:
  - a) On Wallenpaupack Creek.
  - b) From the Ledgesdale Bridge downstream about one-quarter mile.
  - c) From the dam to a point about 600 feet south.
  - d) From Cairns Island to the Pike County shore line.

The Pennsylvania Fish & Boat Commission is charged with establishing and enforcing boating regulations within the State. The three regulations above are just a few of the more important rules for boating on this lake.
